APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all metered water service except that provided to single-family residential customers.

TERRITORY

A portion of the community of Lancaster and vicinity, Los Angeles County.

The service charge is a readiness-to-serve charge which is applicable to all metered service and to which is added the charge for water used computed at the quantity rate.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Qualifying non-profit group living facilities, agricultural employee housing facilities, and migrant farm worker housing centers are eligible for credits as shown on Schedule LIRA
2. All bills are subject to any applicable surcharges on Schedules RSF and LIRA-SC.
3. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fees set forth on Schedule UF.
4. A WRAM-MCBA true-up surcharge of \$0.0758 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 18 months from May 13, 2009, the effective date of Advice Letter 1908.
5. A surcredit of \$0.1250 is to be added to each bill on or after June 1, 2009, the effective date of Advice Letter 1923-A to reflect the Cost of Capital authorized by the CPUC in Decision 09-05-019. (T)
6. An ICBA surcharge of \$0.1536 per 100 cu. ft. of water used is to be applied to the quantity rates for 12 months from January 15, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 1965.
7. Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 of D.09-05-014, D.09-05-016 and D.09-05-017 a one-time surcharge of \$0.2441 is to be added to each bill after January 15, 2010, the effective date of Advice Letter 1967 to recover amounts paid for intervenor compensation. (N)
