To the California Public Utilities Commission:

California Water Service Company (“Cal Water”) respectfully submits this Tier 2 advice letter requesting authority to add or modify the following tariff sheets for its new, regulated Travis District:

Summary

In compliance with Ordering Paragraph 4 of D.18-12-020, Cal Water requests authority to add a new Potable Water Service tariff and a new Service Area Map for the Travis District. Cal Water submits this request via Tier 2 advice letter with a requested effective date of July 1, 2019.

Background

On May 15, 2017, Cal Water filed an Application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to provide regulated potable water service to Travis Air Force Base (“TAFB”) and to establish rates for service under the Commission’s jurisdiction. The Commission provided conditional approval of a CPCN in D.18-12-020 as follows:

Ordering Paragraph 2 states:

The application of the California Water Service Company for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to serve the Travis Air Force Base is granted subject to the condition in Ordering Paragraph 3.

Ordering Paragraph 3 states:

California Water Service Company will have 90 days to renegotiate and modify the contract as follows. First, Section C.11.4 of the Regulated Tariff Rate contract shall be modified to reflect the Commission’s ultimate jurisdiction over approval of future system deficiency corrections, upgrades, connections, renewals, and replacements that are funded through the Commission’s ratemaking authority. Second, pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B,



Water Industry Rule 8.3 and Public Utilities Code Section 2712, the contract shall be modified to reflect that it shall, at all times, be subject to such modifications as the Commission may direct from time to time in the exercise of its jurisdiction. California Water Service Company shall submit the modified contract and a blackline reflecting changes made to the original version of the contract to the Commission's Water Division through a Tier 2 Advice Letter filing for compliance approval before a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is granted. Pursuant to GO 96-B, Water Industry Rule 8.3, the Tier 2 Advice Letter shall be filed at least 30 days before the effective date of providing service to Travis AFB.

Ordering Paragraph 4 states:

Assuming that the Advice Letter required by Ordering Paragraph 3 is approved, and only after this step has taken place, California Water Service Company shall file, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 454, supplemental Tier 2 advice letters to implement tariff rate schedules attached to Application 17-05-022—Appendix B Potable Water Service, and Appendix C, Service Area Map. The effective date of the revised schedules shall be five days after the date of filing.

Discussion

Cal Water renegotiated and modified its Regulated Tariff Rate Contract with the Federal Government to address the two contract modification requirements set forth in Ordering Paragraph 3 of D.18-12-020. Cal Water submitted Advice Letter 2333 on December 19, 2019, at least 30 days before the effective date of providing service to Travis AFB. With the approval of AL 2333 on January 17, 2019, the Commission authorized the creation of a new regulated district, the Travis District.

Consistent with the Commission's requirement to recalculate rates to reflect the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act ("TCJA"), the Federal Government has requested that Cal Water recalculate the proposed tariffed rates to reflect the decrease in the corporate tax from 35% to 21%. The attached tariff reflects those changes.

The attached tariff also reflects the inclusion of the standard Special Conditions for all regulated customers that reference the CPUC User Fee (Schedule UF), the LIRA surcharge, the RSF surcharge, and other relevant additional surcharges and credits contained in Schedule AS.

With this advice letter, Cal Water submits a new potable water tariff and a new service area map for the Travis District in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 4 of D.18-12-020.

Requested Effective Date

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 4 of D.18-12-020, Cal Water requests that this advice letter become effective on **July 1, 2019**, 5 days after filing.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest. A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on. The advice letter process does not provide for any responses, protests or comments, except for the utility's reply, after the 20-day comment period.

Replies: The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Each reply must be received by the Water Division within 5 business days after the end of the protest period and shall be served on the same day to the person who filed the protest or response. 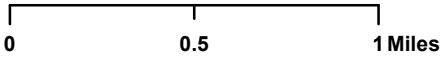
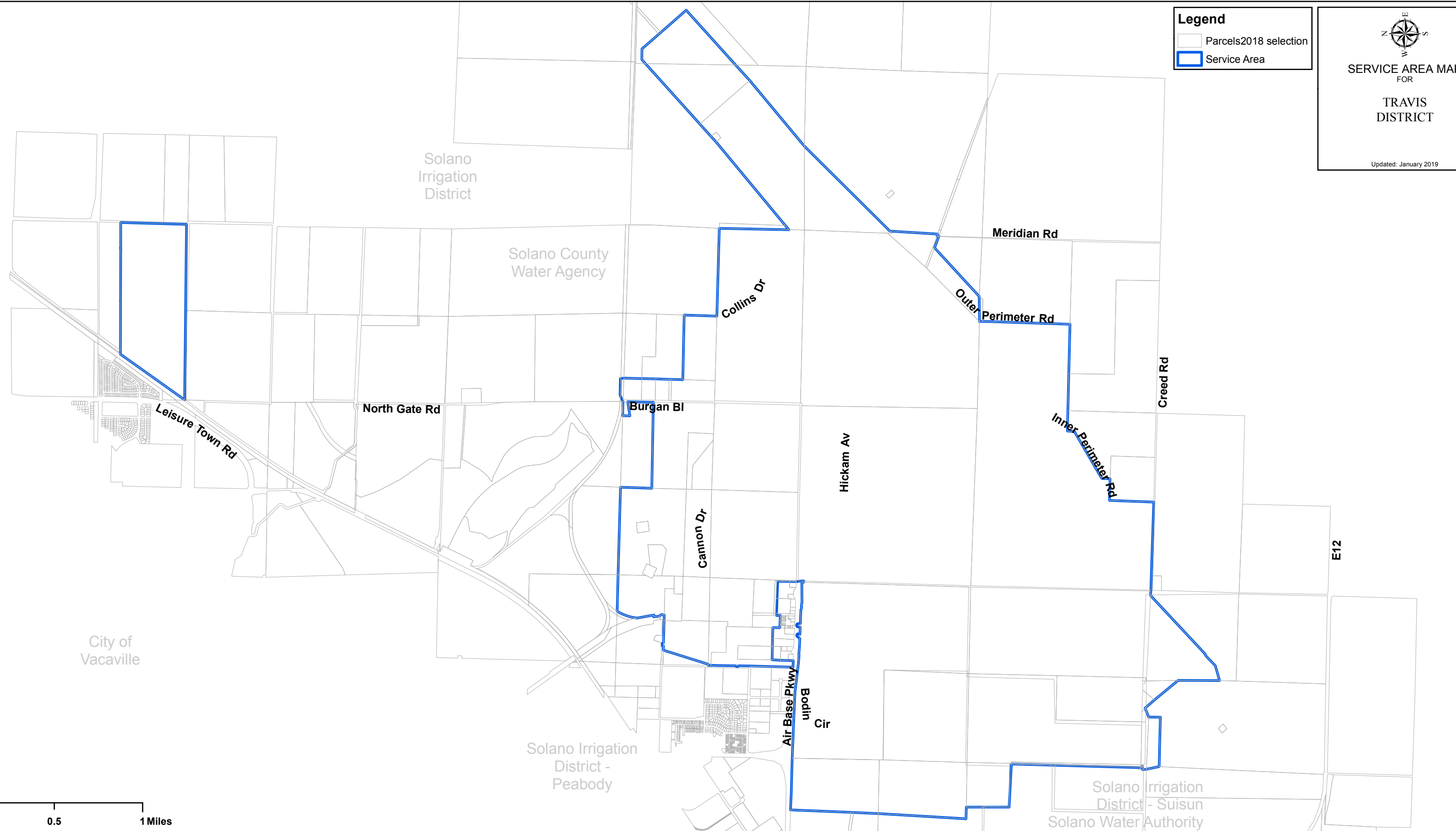
