NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AN URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AND HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING TO

RECEIVE COMMENTS ON THE PROPOSED PLAN

CALIFORNIA WATER SERVICE COMPANY'S HERMOSA - REDONDO DISTRICT

California Water Code, Part 2.6 Chapters 1 through 4 (Sections 10610 through 10656), are known and may be the "Urban Water Management Planning Act."

These California Water Code sections require all urban water suppliers that provide water for municipal purposs directly or indirectly to more than 3,000 customers or supply more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually to pre Urban Water Management Plan as outlined and identified in those sections. This requirement applies to put privately owned water utilities.

The plan must describe and evaluate sources of supply, reasonable and practical efficient uses, reclamation, and i management activities. The components of the plan may vary according to an individual community of characteristics and its capabilities to efficiently use and conserve water. The plan must address measures for rescommercial, governmental, and industrial water demand management.

The act requires urban water suppliers to update their Urban Water Management Plans at least once every fiv and to file updated plans with the Department of Water Resources, the California State Library, and any city or served by the supplier no later than 30 days after adoption.

California Water Service Company (Cal Water) is an investor-owned public utility providing water service that California. In addition, Cal Water is regulated by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC).

One of Cal Wister's service areas is the Hermosa - Redondo District, which is located in Los Angeles Coun Hermosa - Redondo District serves the cities of Hermosa Beach and Redondo Beach and approximately five of the City of Torrance.

As a defined urban water supplier, Cal Water is preparing an update to its Urban Water Management Plan I address the water service conditions in the Hermosa - Redondo District. It is Cal Water's intent to adopt that a file that plan as required with the Department of Water Resources, the California State Library, and any city of within which Cal Water provides service.

A key focus of this UWMP update is the conservation requirement set forth in Senate Bill 7 (SBx7-7) as p. November 2009. SBx7-7 mandates a statewide 20% reduction in per capita urban water use by 2020. In quantify the objectives and identify the means of achieving this mandated demand reduction, Cal Water has p a Conservation Master Plan.

Cal Water is in the process of expanding current conservation programs and developing new programs for districts. Over the next five years, Cal Water conservation programs expenditures are likely to increase, due measure to recently adopted state policies requiring future reductions in per capita urban water use. These state include SBx7-7, as well as recent decisions by the California Public Utilines Commission (CPUC) directing and B water utilities to adopt conservation programs and rate structures designed to achieve reductions in privater use, as well as the Memorandian of Understanding Regarding Urban Water Conservation in California of which Cal Water has been a signatory since 1991.

The Conservation Master Plan for the Hermona - Redondo District will be presented to the Cities, Counties an served by Cal Water's Hermona - Redondo District in conjunction with the UWMP.

Schedule of upcoming actions:
